D. BACKGROUND AND EXPERIENCE

CDA College Pafos is a private institution of Higher Education which started its operations in the academic year 2014/15. It is the local branch of CDA College which also operates in Nicosia, Larnaca and Limassol towns with a long history of operation which dates back to 1976.

The college provides professional and academic programmes of study in Secretarial Studies, Travel and Tourism, Aesthetics, Hairdressing, Business Administration, Accounting and Funeral Administrator –
